

# Bookbinding processing for inserts

Valid as of: November 2023

If not specified otherwise, all information is binding for finishing with perfect binding and saddle stitching.

## 1. Formats

min.: 105 x 148 mm

max.: always 20 mm smaller than the carrier

product in terms of both height and width

## 2. Paper weight and volumes

Matt-coated papers (Vol. 1,0)

2-page:  $120g/m^2 - 300g/m^2$ 4-page:  $100g/m^2 - 300g/m^2$ 6-page:  $60g/m^2 - 250g/m^2$  $\geq 8$ -page:  $54g/m^2 - 200g/m^2$ 

### Gloss-coated papers

2-page: 135g/m² - 350g/m² 4-page: 135g/m² - 350g/m² 6-page: 100g/m² - 300g/m² ≥ 8-page: 80g/m² - 250g/m²

## 3. Composition

Inserts must be closed toward the binding of the carrier product. If a fixed insert is to be attached to the delivered insert, then the adhesive for this fixed insert must run parallel to the binding.

## 4. Insert thickness

max.: 3 mm

### 5. Number und Placement

Four inserts in two undefined positions.

# 6. Thickness of the carrier product

Inserts in one position: min. 3 mm Inserts in two positions: min. 5 mm

### 7. Provision

Four working days, at the latest (ten working days, at the earliest) before the scheduled start of processing and notification by telephone at least two days before delivery.

# 8. Packaging

Depending upon the composition of the product, either in cardboard boxes or on pallets.

#### Cardboard boxes:

The inserts are to be packaged lying in the same direction, free of play, protected by partitions and intermediate sheets so that they do not slip, and with a gripping height of at least 100 mm.

#### Pallets:

The inserts may not be placed crosswise within the individual layer; each layer should be provided with an intermediate shelf at least 2 mm thick. Stretched pallets must be supplied with corner/ edge protectors. The merchandise will be delivered exclusively on euro-pallets.

## 9. Special requirements

Products, samples and requirements deviating from the data specified above must be specially requested before production, sampled well beforehand and may be subject to a test run.

## 10. Reception of goods
